



COMMUNITY & VOLUNTEERING

The Landscape Stewardship Department would like to see this vision come to fruition; however, we need the assistance of those who reside in this community to assist us. No one group of people are more necessary for accomplishing these goals than the residents who reside within the Mountain Park Neighborhood. We have received several inquiries regarding the establishment of a volunteer initiative to help keep this community vibrant, healthy, and at the forefront of sustainable beauty. Therefore; beginning March 16, 2019 the Landscape Stewardship Department will sponsor a pilot community volunteer program focusing on roadside and community cleanup as well as invasive species management.

This is an opportunity for Mountain Park Community Members to help create the neighborhood they wish to see, acquire knowledge regarding the management of the common spaces, and get a chance to meet and talk with the landscape stewards that take care of the Common Property. A monthly volunteer event will be held every 3rd Saturday of the month through October 19, 2019. If this pilot program is successful we would like to see it continue indefinitely, though that relies solely on community involvement.
