



Tree Pruning Guidelines

All tree work must follow [Lake Oswego applicable tree codes](#) and all **tree pruning** on MPHOA Common Property must follow the [Policies and practices of the Common Property Committee](#) including this guideline. If you are uncertain if the tree is on common or private property, submit a [Common Property Work Request \(CPWR\)](#), and the Landscape Stewardship Department will assist you. Landscape Stewards will utilize the [City of Lake Oswego GIS and Tax Map](#) to determine property boundaries. Landscape Stewards may consult with an ISA Certified Arborist related to tree work.
