Camp Schedule

Winter Break Camp 2020 runs December 21-23 and December 28-30. Children can be dropped off at the Hawthorn Room outside doors as early as 9:00am. Children must be picked up by 5:00pm. If children are not picked up by 5:00pm, a *late fee* of \$1.00 per minute for each child will be charged. A detailed schedule of the camp week will be given to parents when they drop off their child on their first day of camp. The camp schedule will be a useful tool for knowing when and where your child will be at any point during the camp week in case you need to pick-up or drop off your child at an unusual time.

Camp Fees

MEMBER
3-DAYS: \$165

NON-MEMBER
3-DAYS: \$225

Due to COVID-19 camp mandates, groups must be stable (same group for full week). Therefore, the only registration option is to enroll for all three days of camp for each week.

What to Bring

We will be doing a varied assortment of activities at camp that will require children to be prepared for anything! Please make sure that they bring a backpack, water bottle, closed-toed shoes, a raincoat, and a change of clothing. Children will also need to bring their own *sack lunch* as well as *three snacks* for each day of camp. **Swimming is currently TBD due to COVID-19.** You will be notified by e-mail if your camper needs to bring a swimsuit, towel, and bag to put wet clothing in.

Camper Expectations

It is the participant's responsibility to follow instructions, behave positively, and be an active member of all program activities. Campers are expected to function 100% independently as individuals and within a group setting. They must be able to comprehend and follow basic instructions and be able to change clothes and use restroom facilities without assistance. Staff to camper ratio constraints disallow KidZone from being able to provide extra assistance to individual campers. Any behavior deemed inappropriate, unsafe, or disrespectful by Mountain Park HOA staff will be faced with consequences. Emotional or physical bullying of any type will not be tolerated and is grounds for suspension from camp. Failure to adhere to all program policies is cause for dismissal with no refund of fees.

Cancellation Policy

A complete refund/credit will be given if written notification of cancellation is given at least *two weeks prior* to the start of the program. No refund will be given if a participant leaves a program early for any reason, cancels within two weeks of the start of the program, or does not show up for the program. Missing a scheduled program for medical reasons warrants a refund as long as documentation from a medical professional can be provided to Mountain Park HOA. Refunds/credits will not be provided in the case of any emergency facility closures unless determined otherwise by the Community Relations Manager.
