



# Tree Removal Guidelines

All **tree removals** must follow [Lake Oswego applicable tree codes](#) including procuring permits for removal. On MPHOA Common Property, tree removals must follow the [Policies & Practices of the Common Property Committee](#) including this guideline. If you are uncertain if the tree is on common or private property, submit a [Common Property Work Request](#) (CPWR), and the Landscape Stewardship Department will assist you. Landscape Stewards will utilize the [City of Lake Oswego GIS and Tax Map](#) to determine property boundaries. Landscape Stewards may consult with an ISA Certified Arborist related to tree removal.
