Requirements

- Current certifications in Lifeguarding, CPR/AED, and First Aid (American Red Cross preferred; must be acquired by start date)

- Must work at least 1 shift per 12-month period

Physical Demands

- Ability to sit, stand, walk, swim, stoop, bend, and lift arms above shoulders
- Regular exposure to chemically treated water
- Must occasionally lift up to 50 pounds
- Visual requirements include close, distance, peripheral vision, depth perception, and ability to adjust focus

Work Environment

- Indoor pool facility with moderate noise levels
- Exposure to chlorine and other pool chemicals
- Must be comfortable working around water for extended periods
